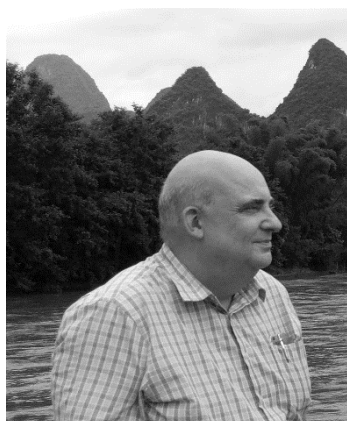


Frankfurt / Aachen 13. November 2020
